

Michael Maliakel (pronounced "Molly-uh-kell") is currently starring as the title role in Disney's Aladdin on Broadway. An award-winning Indian-American actor and singer, Michael was recently featured in the PBS concert special "Broadway's Brightest Lights" alongside Broadway veterans Megan Hilty and Nikki Renee Daniels. He recently made his Kennedy Center debut in the critically acclaimed production of Andrew Lloyd Webber's Sunset Boulevard starring Tony award winner Stephanie J. Block. Prior to the pandemic, Michael toured North America with the 25th Anniversary production of The Phantom of the Opera. He made his Off-Broadway debut in Anything Can Happen: The Songs of Maury Yeston. Other recent stage highlights include Bernstein's MASS (Marin Alsop and the Chicago Symphony - Ravinia Festival), Georg in She Loves Me (PlayMakers Repertory Company), and the record-breaking world premiere of Mira Nair's Monsoon Wedding (Berkeley Repertory Theatre). Michael's on-screen work includes roles on "BULL" and "FBI," both on CBS, as well as appearances on "Good Morning America" and "The View".

Michael has performed as a soloist with orchestras and ensembles across the country including the National Philharmonic, the Tallahassee Symphony, the Savannah Philharmonic, the American Pops Orchestra, the Albany Symphony, the Orchestra of St. Luke's, the New Jersey Festival Orchestra, TENET Vocal Artists, the Greenwich Choral Society, the Harmonium Choral Society, and the Long Island Choral Society. He has received top awards from several organizations including the American Traditions Vocal Competition, the Lotte Lenya Competition, the NATS National Music Theater Competition, and the Gerda Lissner Foundation. Michael received his earliest musical training at the American Boychoir School. He attended Georgetown University and the Peabody Institute of Music at Johns Hopkins University.
